

THE JOHN E. WEEMS GRADUATE SCHOOL TEACHER APPRECIATION GRANT

Working teachers seeking the Master of Education (M.Ed.) degree can receive \$200 credit for <u>each</u> three credit hour course they are enrolled in at Meredith College. This Teacher Appreciation Grant is one way that Meredith College demonstrates its continuing commitment to North Carolina schools and teachers.

To qualify for the Teacher Appreciation Grant, you must:

- 1. Be a degree candidate in a Master of Education (M.Ed.) program. Students enrolled in a Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.) program, add-on licensure only, and other post-baccalaureate students are not eligible.
- 2. Be under contract in a public or private North Carolina school, at the elementary, middle, or secondary level.
- 3. Provide verification of employment and student status as indicated below.
