

## FIRST FLOOR





Room 129 & 131 are ceramic studio spaces and are frequently loud and crowded. The Frankie G. Weems Gallery is a designated quiet area, unless noted otherwise.



The female bathroom on the first floor is wheel-chair accessible. The entry door may be heavy when closed. Please alert staff for assistance.



The ceramics studios (room 129 and 131) work with clay and glaze, and as such are often strongly scented.



The department provides Braille labels for the number assigned to each room; this signage is located to the right or left of each door-frame. There is no description of the room's purpose provided in Braille. We do offer Braille labels within the Frankie G. Weems Gallery for our rotating exhibits.



Doors marked orange indicate fire exits. The stairs are marked in orange as well, and can be found at the front and back of the building. Our elevator- marked on the map- is across from office 106.

## SECOND FLOOR




Rooms 208, 209, and 210 are studio spaces, and are frequently loud and crowded.
