

# PLAN FOR TRANSFER TO MEREDITH COLLEGE FROM NC COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOR COMMUNICATION: MASS COMMUNICATION CONCENTRATION (B.A.)

## THIS PLAN IS FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE

- (2) not sure whether they will complete their associate's degree before transferring to Meredith.

We recommend you take the courses in this plan to maximize the number of credits that will fulfill requirements at Meredith for the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Communication.

If you transfer before completing your A.A., you will be able to use all courses listed below (Semesters 1-4) toward fulfilling requirements for your degree at Meredith.
