Day 1 - 09 JUL (WED) - ARRIVE IN RAPID CITY, SOUTH DAKOTA

Day 2 - 10 JUL (THU) - RAPID CITY - BADLANDS NATIONAL PARK - CUSTER STATE PARK

- Visit Mount Rushmore National Memorial

- Afterwards, drive the scenic Spearfish Canyon for an overnight at the exclusive Spearfish Canyon Lodge
